Winners will be announced on Thursday, December 2, 2010 at 5:45 p.m. at the Main Street/Elk Avenue stage prior to "The Lighting of the Village". People's Choice Award voting ends Sunday, December 5, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. with the winner announced at the Grand Finale at 5:00 p.m. in the Old Town Amphitheater at City Hall.

**Rules: Non-edible items are not allowed** (i.e. candy wrappers, popsicle sticks, lights). The Gingerbread house must be constructed of edible ingredients (i.e. gingerbread, cookies, candies, crackers, chocolate, etc.) House must be on a self-supporting base or board no larger than 24" x 24". The entire structure may be no taller than 2 feet at the highest point. Entries must be set up in the Center for the Arts between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. on December 1, 2010 and be removed from the Center for the Arts display area between 5 p.m. – 6 p.m. on Sunday, December 5, or 9 a.m. – 10 p.m. on Monday, December 6, 2010.

# 2010 Gingerbread House Contest

## INFORMATION & REGULATIONS

### 1. Size, Subject, and Judging Criteria:

The gingerbread entry may not exceed 2 feet in height, including the board/material used for the base, and may not exceed 2 feet in width or depth. It is suggested you use 1/2" or 3/4" plywood for the bases.

Creations may be submitted under one of the following categories: Youth (12 and under); Teen (13-19); Amateur; Professional; Johnson & Wales Future Chef Award for ATC students.

Houses are judged on the following criteria: overall appearance, originality, creative impression, and difficulty. All rulings by the judges are final and are in no way influenced by anyone associated with the City of Rock Hill. The public will be invited to vote for the People's Choice Award by donating one dollar per each vote for their favorite entry. Donations will benefit Habitat for Humanity of York County.

### 2. Product List:

Except for the base, the entry must be made completely of edible products and the structure must be primarily of gingerbread. Recipes for both basic gingerbread and royal icing are available on-line at [www.pasterywiz.com/cakes/gingerbread](http://www.pasterywiz.com/cakes/gingerbread). Edible materials are not limited to sweets. No artificial display materials such as Styrofoam, interior lighting, or landscaping are to be used in the construction. All candies/materials must be unwrapped and free of any inedible materials.

### 3. Entry Forms:

Entry forms are available online at [www.ChristmasVilleRockHill.com](http://www.ChristmasVilleRockHill.com) and in printed form at York County Natural Gas Authority and the City of Rock Hill Economic and Urban Development office in City Hall.

### 4. Set Up and Removal:

Entries must be set up in the Center for the Arts in downtown Rock Hill on Wednesday, December 1, between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. Entries will be on display from Thursday, December 2, until Sunday, December 5. Houses must be removed between 5 p.m. – 6 p.m. on Sunday, December 6, or 9 a.m. – 10 a.m. on Monday, December 6, 2010. Houses left after that time will be considered to have been donated and will be removed and allocated at the discretion of the Gettys Center staff. Public judging will begin at 11 a.m. on Thursday, December 2.

On-site construction, decoration, or assembling (other than minor repairs) will not be permitted.

Entrants agree that their name, photograph, and photo of entry may be used for publicity or advertisement without any compensation to the entrant.

### 5. Awards:

First prize for all categories except the People's Choice Award will receive \$100 cash. Second and Third place will be awarded in each of the categories and will receive gift awards, including the People's Choice Award.

### 6. Hold Harmless:

The City of Rock Hill and sponsoring agencies are not responsible for theft, damage, acts of nature, or destruction of entries.
